Here are just SOME of the advantages over the old bulletin board:

Other people that "subscribe" to the same category (above) will automatically be notified of new messages

Adam Marshall and his wife Kristin have been instrumental in upgrading the electronic bulletin board and building the web site. They spend hours and hours each week on Association stuff for all of our benefit. Thanks Adam and Kristin!!

Essentially we have upgraded to the industry standard for internet bulletin boards.

*We can now post images (lost pets stuff for sale etc.)

*Users can subscribe to topics and be emailed when new posts on that subject are made (automatically).

*Users can privately message one another.

*Ability to email users from board (email everyone that posted on a particular topic).

*Ability to easily include links, including to YouTube/videos

*Easier for users to register.

*More available plug-ins for us to customize the software for our needs.

*Theoretically easier for users to navigate, etc. However it currently doesn't look this way due to templates, etc.

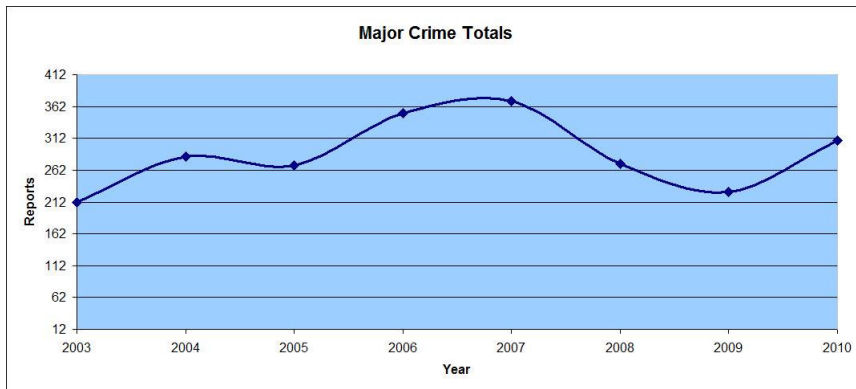
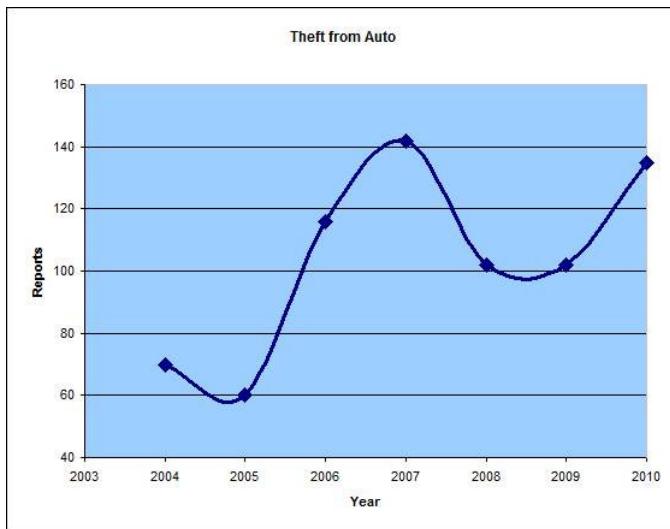


Crime Statistics

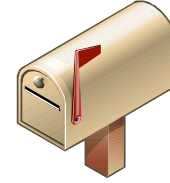
