## Free Hands-On Fairs at Providence

After welcoming over 8,000 area residents to their Grand Opening weekend, Providence Regional Medical Center has decided to provide still more opportunities for the public to get to know the Hospital and to learn to better care for their own health.

For bargain hunters, this means **\$10 flu shots!** Other screenings (dexascan for osteoporosis and blood pressure tests) are also featured.

The Providence Health Fairs all take place on a Saturday, from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

They happen once a month in the main concourse of the new Providence Cymbaluk Medical Tower, 1700 13<sup>th</sup> St. Dates are October 15, November 12, December 10 and (in 2012) January 7.

Providence Hospital clinical nurse educators, physicians and surgeons are volunteering to host 30 booths on a variety of health topics—most of which are interactive activities for kids and adults.

Booths will be hosted by maternity services, pediatrics, cardiac, pulmonary, infection control, IV therapy, emergency services, stroke, chemical dependency, sexual assault nurses and more with screenings, giveaways, activities, games and prizes.

A real DaVinci surgical robot will be available for folks to sit in the console and take for a test drive! Several of the demonstrations will provide hands on information of interest to seniors, including a lifeline demo for seniors living alone.

## New EvCC Construction Means the Re-Design of Neighborhood

### ***College Officials Endeavor to Add to the Attractiveness of the North Broadway Area***

The Royal Motel (Broadway and Tenth) is presently being demolished to make way for the newest facility on the growing EvCC campus, the Nursing and Health Sciences Building. The 37.5 million dollar project is planned to open in spring, 2013.

College President David Beyer commented during the ground breaking ceremony on September 14<sup>th</sup> that one of the objectives the college has and always includes when planning new facilities is to make the neighborhood more attractive. John Olson, PhD., resident of the Northwest neighborhood and Vice-President of College Advancement explained that making the neighborhood more attractive was one of the policy objectives instituted by former College President Michael Kearns when he developed many of the new building projects currently seeing completion.

It shows. Northwest Neighborhood residents have noticed that the attractive new signage installed this past year throughout the entire campus has been accompanied by an extensive sprucing-up of campus landscaping.

Although not a part of the new construction, Frasier's Sports Bar & Grill at the southwest corner of Broadway and 10<sup>th</sup> was purchased by the College in November and was recently demolished. For the time being, it the site will be used for parking.



### ***Medical Synergy in the N.W. Neighborhood***

The Providence Everett Healthcare Clinic will move from College Plaza (across Broadway) into the new facility when it opens in 2013. Students in the nursing curriculum at EvCC already work at the clinic as part of their training regimen; training takes place at the new Providence Hospital as well; the Hospital also plays a role in the providing a hands on understanding of new technology for the College's nursing instructors.

EMTs, medical assistants and phlebotomy students will also receive instruction at the new facility.

The University of Washington/Bothell offers a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing for registered nurses at EvCC's campus as part of the University Center.
